

# Curriculum

St. Peter's Preschool will follow a curriculum designed to promote both social and emotional growth focusing on developing a positive self-esteem for each child. To meet these goals children will be exposed to various academic readiness activities through active discovery and guided learning. Activities, stories, songs, and projects will be centered around weekly themes. Field trips, visitors, dress up days and special snacks will also be planned to support the curriculum. Development of social skills will be accomplished during daily circle and free play experiences.



Spiritual growth will be nurtured through Bible stories, songs, and Christian character lessons. The children will be part of a Kindness Curriculum that will expose them to community service projects on a monthly basis. Projects will relate to a book read to the class.

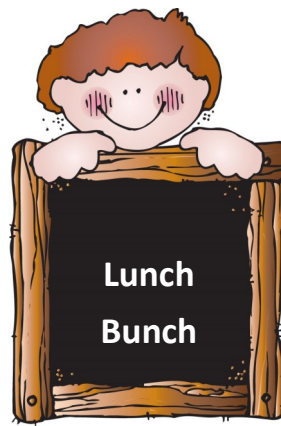


- ◆ Potty trained: The 3's need to be able to use the bathroom independently.

Lunch Bunch is a program children in the 3 & 4 year old classes are invited to register for on a monthly basis. Sessions run October through May. Lunch Bunch class time is 11:30-1:15pm and the rate is \$20 per session. Various topics like Popcorn, Rocks, and The Three Little Pigs are taught.

## Daily Schedule

The daily routine for each class will include circle time, center/project time, snack time, free play, music time, story time, and weather permitting, outside play. During circle time the children will participate in prayer, pledge, calendar, weather and a lesson focusing on the curriculum to develop fine motor skills and explore different art mediums. Snack will be provided by the preschool and will meet the needs of all children. During free play the children will choose a dramatic play area to explore while working on social skills. The curriculum includes monthly Bible story and nursery rhyme lessons.



## Registration

Children will be considered registered once the following materials are returned:

- \* Student Registration Packet
- \* Copy of Birth Certificate (if not already on file)
- \* \$70 non-refundable registration fee (a check made out to St. Peter's Preschool or cash)



Student Physical will be due by June 30, 2022. Doctors will need to use the Illinois form found on our website.

## Tuition and Fees

Tuition will be collected the first of every month from August 1, 2022 to May 1, 2023 for a total of ten monthly payments. .

2 Year Olds: \$1,340/year/\$134 month

3 Year Olds: Two Days: \$1,440 year/\$144 mo.  
Four Days: \$2,240 year/\$224 mo.

4 Year Olds: \$2240 year/ \$224 month

A fall fundraiser will be offered to all families. Profit made from the fundraiser will be deducted from the tuition balance as of December 1st.

\*Multiple children discount: A \$100 discount per child will be applied to the May tuition payment.
