Monday/Tuesday

- Introduce the Letter “Z” and “Zippy the Zebra”
- Children will go on a letter “Z” hunt in the classroom and sing song, “Letters A to Z,” using alphabet stick puppets.
- Table-Time Activity #1: Children will glue zippers on the letter “Z”.
- Fine-Motor Activity: Children will complete “Mouthwatering Melon” by tearing green and black construction paper.
- Storytime: Children will listen to the story, “Waiting for Wings” by Lois Ehlert
- Number “10” Boxes go home today! Help your child place ten of the same item into his/her number box.

Wednesday/Thursday

- Introduce Religion Lesson: “Thank You God for Friends” and have a discussion afterward about how the children have fun with their friends.
- Table Time Activity #1: Children will count out their “10” items from their number “10” boxes by placing the items in an empty egg carton.
- Fine-Motor Activity: Children will remove hidden beads out of therapy putty to strengthen their finger muscles.
- Storytime: Children will listen to the story, “A Butterfly’s Life” by Nancy Dickman
- Review Colors using “The Color Book” that the children worked on all year long. This book will come home at the end of the year in each child’s scrapbook.
- Sunglasses Day!
