## ***Monday/Tuesday***

- Introduce the Letter "T" and "Tootie the Turtle"
- Children will go on a letter "T" hunt in the classroom and sing song, "Letters A to Z," using alphabet stick puppets.
- Table-Time Activity: Children will glue toothpicks onto the letter "T".
- Fine-Motor Activity: Children will make "Humpty Dumpty's Wall" by cutting red strips of construction paper into smaller pieces.
- Storytime: Children will listen to the story, "Bear Wants More-A Springtime Story" by Karma Wilson
- Introduce Nursery Rhyme: "Humpty Dumpty"
- Number "7" boxes go home today!

## ***Wednesday/Thursday***

- Introduce "Olive Oval"
- The children will go on an oval shape hunt in the classroom.
- Table-Time Activity: Children will make "Olive Oval" stick puppets.
- Counting Activity: Children will count out their "7" items from their number boxes and place 4-7 watermelons in gardens.
- Storytime: Children will listen to the story, "The Story of Peter Rabbit" by Beatrix Potter.
- Review Nursery Rhyme: "Humpty Dumpty"
- Sensory Table will be filled with uncooked beans and gold for St. Patrick's Day!
- Spirit Day – Wear your St. Peter's Preschool t-shirt to school today!

## **Humpty Dumpty Sensory Activity**

Here is a fun plastic egg activity to do at home. The game is called, "What's in the Egg?" Here is what you will need for the game:

- 12 similar colored plastic eggs
- Fillers (uncooked rice, uncooked pasta, beans, salt, small puzzle pieces, and small paper clips)

Here are the instructions for this sensory activity:

- Place each of the fillers into two of the plastic eggs. So two eggs are filled with rice, two eggs are filled with salt, etc.
- Mix up the 12 eggs and place in an egg carton.
- Ask your child to pick one egg, shake it gently, and find the other egg with the exact same sound.
- Have your child play the game until all the eggs are matched up.
