Monday/Tuesday

- **Fine-Motor Activity:** Children will have time at the beginning of the day to manipulate “Watermelon” play dough, using play dough cookie cutters, scissors, rolling pins, etc.

- Children will go on a letter “A” hunt in the classroom.

Wednesday/Thursday

- Children will go on a circle hunt in the classroom.
- **Table Time Activity #1:** Children will make “Cindy Circle” stick puppets.
- **Table Time Activity #2:** Children will play “Shape Sock” game with the shapes: circle, triangle, and square.
