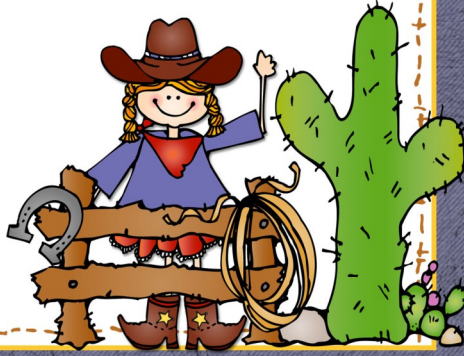




Mrs. B's Class

Monday

Today we will learn about letter Gg! We will learn that it can make two sounds— gumball and gingerbread. We will read “Gorilla Be Good” by Maria Fleming. The children will work on a G book, a gingerbread man of G’s and C’s, and make a gumball machine. Our story is “Clark the Shark Loves Christmas” by Bruce Hale.



Tuesday

We will learn about the number 7 today! We will also learn about trapezoids! We will read “Seven Magic Hats” Liza Charlesworth and “Christmas Eve Good-night” Doug Cushman. We will sort some shapes, make a trapezoid Christmas tree, and write some 7’s.



Wednesday

Today we learn about the gingerbread man by reading “The Gingerbread Man” David Cutts. After sequencing the story together, we will measure using a gingerbread man stick, make a gingerbread house, and easel paint a gingerbread boy or girl. Our story will be “The Gingerbread Girl” Campbell Ernst.



Thursday

We will continue hearing the story of the Gingerbread man, but today we will hear the story “Gingerbread Baby” by Jan Brett. We will draw pictures of where we would run if we were a gingerbread boy, count out candies for a gingerbread house, and add details to our painting. Our story is “Gingerbread Mouse” Katy Braten.
