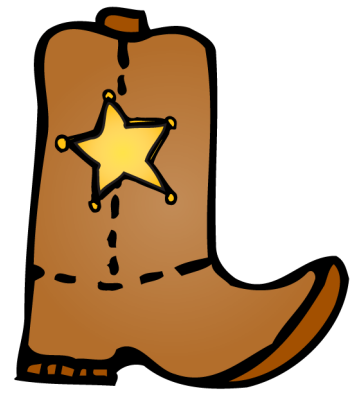


Mrs. B's Newsletter

TUESDAY

The next number to learn is number 11. We will group items and count to 11. We will talk about the concept of above and under— practicing with blocks. Today we will listen to the February Kindness story “Heartprints” and tie fleece pillows at play time to donate to Silver Cross Hospital.



Wednesday

We will be learning about dental health today and tomorrow. Our focus today will be how many teeth we have and what baby teeth and permanent teeth are. I'm sure the idea of the



tooth fairy will also be discussed! We will read “How Many Teeth” Paul Showers and “Tooth Trouble” Jane Clarke. At centers the children will easel paint with a tooth brush, draw what makes them smile and glue teeth onto their ‘mouth’ - then counting how many they glued on.

Thursday

Our focus today will be the parts of tooth, types of teeth, and the importance of going to the dentist. We will read “All About Teeth” Mari Schuh, “At the Dentist” Mari Schuh and “Big Shark’s Lost Tooth” Steve Metzger. At one of our centers today, we will be making a chart to track when the children brush their teeth.
