STORY: "I See Spring" by Charles Ghigna & Number "4"

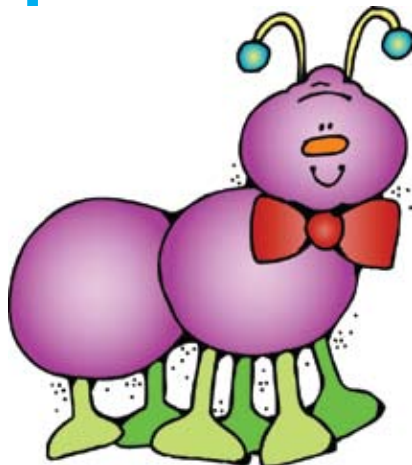
PROJECT: "Cracked Egg" Fork paint a chick shape yellow

PROJECT: "Caterpillar" Balloon paint circles to make caterpillar

LEARNING TIME: "Feed the Caterpillar" Children take turns to feed the hungry caterpillar

MOTOR: "Caterpillar Movement" Move to hunger caterpillar song
